- **Office Volunteer**
 - work directly with women in crisis;
 - 3 hour shifts, one day a week or more;
 - Full training provided. You just need to be a compassionate, caring individual.

- **Board of Directors Member**
 - Board members should have business, non-profit, medical or counseling background;
 - The Board meets for two hours quarterly either at our office or via telephone conference call;
 - The Board reviews our current operations to insure we are in compliance with our charter and establishing policy for our Director and other volunteers;
 - Individual board members take on additional projects such as managing our marketing/advertising program; publishing our quarterly newsletter; developing and managing our fund raising program.

- **Project Volunteer**
 - **Maternity clothing coordinator** – sort maternity clothing and finding sources. (1-2 times a month)
 - **Baby Layettes Organizer** – organize donations of baby clothing, put together baby layettes for new mothers
 - **Grant Writer** – Can work from home and set own hours
 - **Quarterly Newsletter help** – participate in the organization/article writing and mailing list updates.
 - **Data entry** – help to keep our referral list updated, work on statistics, etc.
 - **Distribute literature** - to colleges and schools
 - **Speaker/presentation** – give talks about Birthright as requested at schools, community events, etc.
 - **Cleaning the office**
 - **Photographer** – take photos at different events for use in the News letter or other advertisements.
 - **Fundraising** - Idea Person and facilitator. Assist at fund raisers.
